By-Law No. 15 THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS

- 1. The Council may, by Resolution which may be in the form as set out in Schedule "A" of this By-Law or to the like effect, cause the destruction of any documents or records of the Municipality after they are no longer required, provided that the Clerk submits to the Council his affidavit set- ting forth each of the documents or records to be destroyed and that he has personally examined each of the documents or records proposed to be destroyed and that there is nothing of value therein.
- 2. The affidavit of the Clerk setting out that he has personally examined each document or record and that there is nothing of value therein may be in the form as set out in Schedule "B" of this By-Law, or to the like effect.
- 3. Nothing in this By-Law shall authorize the destruction of the following documents:
 - 3.(a) Deeds, Mortgages or other documents or records relating to the title of real property;
 - 3.(b) Court records;
 - 3.(c) Records required to be kept by any Statute;
 - 3.(d) Records less than Five (5) years old;
 - 3.(e) Minutes, By-Laws or Resolutions of the Council;
 - 3.(f) Plans and Surveying Records, and
 - 3.(g) Affidavit of the Clerk made pursuant to this By-Law.
