Meteghan Sewer Extension

The work on the Meteghan Sewer Extension, a project which was approved through Building Canada Fund - Small Communities Fund, has begun. All residents along the line will be contacted by J.R. Eisner Construction or by Paul Dugas, the project inspector, to discuss where the lines up to the individual property lines will be placed. Water tests are currently being carried out at each residence.
