Subject: Second Division Rd - Concession/Margo

Warden LeBlanc,

I would like to draw your attention to the state of the Second Division Rd where the pavement ends in Concession. The dirt road is in terrible condition (see attached photos from earlier this winter). The road does get graded from time to time, but degrades to its previous state in a matter of days. In addition to being hazardous for vehicle traffic, it causes tremendous wear and tear on resident vehicles.

There are numerous year-round residences along Victor Lake. Both CSAP and Tri-county school buses, as well as the snow plow, use Chemin a Victor to turn around. Logging trucks also use the road, and traffic has become much heavier with the development around Belliveau Lake.

I would like to request a long-term fix to the road, and would welcome any solutions that would alleviate this issue.
